

## Fork Mounted Buckets

### Universal Fit Buckets

Universal Fit buckets also referred to as "slip-on-the-forks" forklift accessory buckets. These buckets could be used along with whichever model and make of extendable reach lift truck. If your unit is unable to be matched with a quick-tach unit, another new or used universal fit bucket can be located as an alternative. Typical universal forklift buckets connect to forks that are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Bigger fork pockets can be prearranged via an account executive upon request.

Because they slip directly onto the forks, universal fit buckets stay on the machine and are much less at risk to damage. As opposed to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50 percent. This additional room makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads such as elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.

### Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are constructed for extendable-reach lift trucks. They are built to allow positioning of material way beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on the leading edge and on both sides reinforces strength, resistance to wear and provides supreme durability. Quick-Tach lift truck buckets are augmented by scuff bars along the base of the unit which shield it from abrasion.

Quick-Tach lift buckets can in many cases replace the blades and carriage of a lift truck, which may weigh somewhere between one hundred to seven hundred pounds. These buckets when installed could free up more load capacity, enabling it to deal with both bigger and heavier supplies. The Quick-Tach is able to pour objects about 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are built in a custom fashion so as to suit all the specifications of specific models and makes of forklifts.
